The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (“PGCB”) is pleased to present its fifteenth annual Diversity Report.

Pursuant to §1212 of the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (“Act”), the PGCB is charged with promoting and ensuring diversity, equity, and inclusion in all aspects of legalized gaming. The PGCB developed rules and regulations, 58 Pa. Code §481a, to achieve its objectives. The diversity regulations established policies and procedures for promoting and ensuring that the regulated entities support participation and equity in all aspects of their operations in the Commonwealth.

This report provides information regarding the PGCB’s ongoing efforts in monitoring the activities of Pennsylvania’s licensed gaming facilities (“casinos”) to ensure the Commonwealth’s goals of enhanced representation of diverse groups in the gaming industry and the creation of quality living wage jobs for its residents. Sections 13A04, 1325, and 1510 of the Act require that casinos maintain local preferences in their hiring practices. As Pennsylvania’s gaming industry has developed over the years, diversity, equity, and inclusion have remained at the forefront of the PGCB’s mission. Notwithstanding changes to the Act, casino ownership, casino executive management, or within the PGCB, diversity, equity, and inclusion has been and continues to be an ongoing noteworthy achievement of the entire industry.

The casinos have spent the past two years navigating significant obstacles resulting from the COVID-19 Pandemic in an effort to maintain viable business operations. Post pandemic, the casinos are redesigning best practices and developing new alliances. As the casinos emerge from the pandemic fully revitalized and, on the move, they have encountered a highly competitive labor market, shifts in employee expectations, and other economic disruptions that continue to impact the overall employee total. On June 30, 2022, the licensed casinos/resorts employed a total of 14,829 individuals. Residents of the Commonwealth consisted of 89% of the casinos’ workforce. Approximately 43% of the employees were female while 40% of those employed at the casinos were racial minorities. Executive/Management/Professional Staff at the casinos were comprised of 2,370 individuals. Of this total, 36% were female and 26% were racial minorities.

The casinos remain committed to prioritizing the professional development of workers through mentorship programs, tuition reimbursement for continuing education, succession planning, upskilling, and more. These training and retention efforts consistently result in noteworthy internal promotions. Additionally, the casinos remain committed to achieving the Commonwealth’s goal regarding table games employment. Pennsylvania residents currently make up 83% of table games employees.

The casinos remain steadfast in their commitment to vendors and gaming service providers, despite ongoing supply chain challenges and the current economic and business environment. The relationship between casinos and service providers established during the pandemic, has resulted in the formation of specialized purchasing strategies and cost solutions that ensure viability, flexibility, and marketability. Moreover, the casinos continue to support organizations that promote supplier diversity and economic empowerment, such as the Minority Supplier Development Council, the Women’s Business Enterprise Center East, the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development, and the Pennsylvania Department of General Services’ Bureau of Diversity, Inclusion & Small Business Opportunities. Expenditures for each casino are available in the pages that follow.

Philanthropy and community outreach remain a priority for the casinos. The casinos have consistently given support to organizations that provide food and shelter to those in need, medical research and treatment, educational programs and training, scholarships, historical preservation projects, event sponsorships, matching gifts, disaster relief, and public safety. In addition to monetary donations, organizations benefit from voluntary support in the form of days of service involving neighborhood revitalization efforts and in-kind (necessary supplies) donations from casino leadership and staff. This support illustrates the widespread effect of greater economic success locally, regionally, and statewide, thereby giving rise to revenue streams and income that benefit and fortify Commonwealth communities and citizens. Since 2006, the casinos have donated well over \$174.1 million towards corporate social responsibility causes and charitable activities.

The PGCB remains committed to monitoring the activities of the Commonwealth’s licensed casinos in promoting diversity and ensuring compliance with the Act.

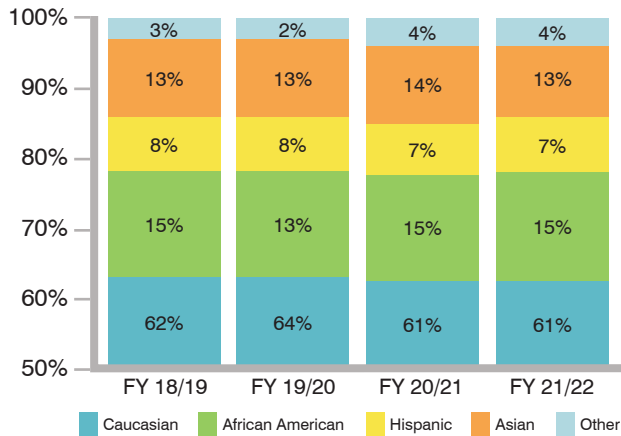


In addition to requirements in both the Gaming Act and the Board’s regulatory policies and procedures, the PGCB requires each Licensee to execute a “Statement of Conditions” in which the Licensee agrees to submit an updated version of its diversity and hiring plans on an annual basis.

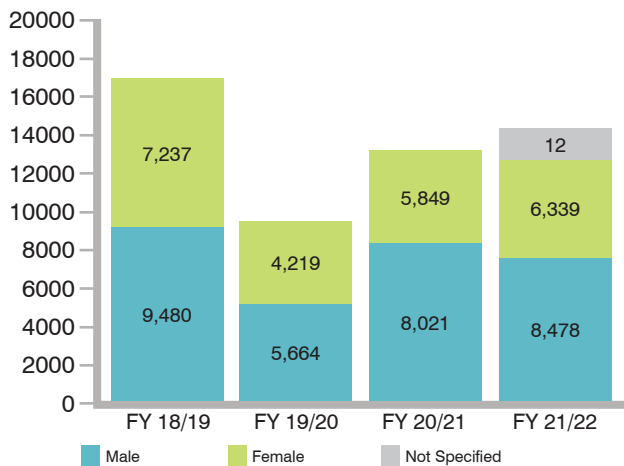
